HAIL DAMAGE REPAIR REPORT

The hail storm that struck Idaho Falls and Ammon in early April damaged our church buildings' roof, siding along the west side of the building and broke the seal on six west facing windows resulting in a little over \$69,000 in damages. Fortunately, none of the damages caused significant structural loss or internal damages.

A general contractor from Blackfoot Idaho was hired to complete the repairs; Murdock Construction. He worked with our insurance company, Brotherhood Mutual, to ensure that all damages were correctly appraised and reimbursed. This process took a little over two months to wade through. Once figures were finalized, work began to replace the shingles on the entire roof, followed by the windows and finally the siding.

We were able to get the siding crew to cover the door casings with metal which were previously standard wooden brick molding – a much needed upgrade at no additional cost!
